Subject: 2008 IRP renewal

Enclosed you will find your 2008 IRP renewal. As you will notice, the renewal looks familiar. We decided that the new IRP system was not performing to Department of Revenue standards, so the implementation of the new system will take place after the 2008 renewal season ends.

We will not send an instruction manual this year. Please refer to the 2007 manual if you have questions. If your manual has been misplaced, you can print a new copy from the website www.truckingks.org.

Renewals will be done the same as in years past. Below is a renewal checklist.

- If miles are listed on your renewal verify they are correct. Mileage year is 7/1/2006 to 6/30/2007.
- Update your MCS-150 annually, this is a PRISM requirement. You can do this on-line at www.safersys.org.
- Provide a current copy of the paid Federal Heavy Vehicle Use Tax (form 2290) for all vehicles registered over 54,000 pounds.
- Provide a copy of your paid personal property tax from the county if you are a private carrier (no haul for hire authority).
- Owner/Operators and Custom Harvesters need to provide a copy of their Certificate of Insurance that indicates the level of liability insurance. Insurance needs to be at least \$750,000.
- If you have haul for hire authority, provide a copy of your Kansas Ad-Valorem tax filing.

The renewal deadline has not changed. All 2008 credentials must be in vehicles by March 2, 2008.
